Spiral Trays in Burkina Weave

Expanding on the weavers of Burkina Faso, Eva guides us to use willow rods, reed or native vines to create a strong open-work tray you can fill with flat bark strips or leave open to absorb the wall behind. Once you get to know the techniques, Eva says it is easy to go into 3 dimensions. Judy's own barks will be sized for the chasework.

This class has been carefully chosen to meet all levels for hand strength. Nonetheless, there will be many starts and much practice to learn this new technique.

Frame Baskets

Eva says, "Sometimes I stumble over wonderful round or oval rings made from wood, bone, metal willow - whatever - and they have inspired me to weave pouches with frames and random weaving, using willow for the frames and different materials for the random weaving, such as bark, leather, reeds or recycled materials."

This class is for all levels of weaver and you can expect each frame piece to be a unique creation. A wide range of materials will be provided but feel free to bring along your own inspirations.
